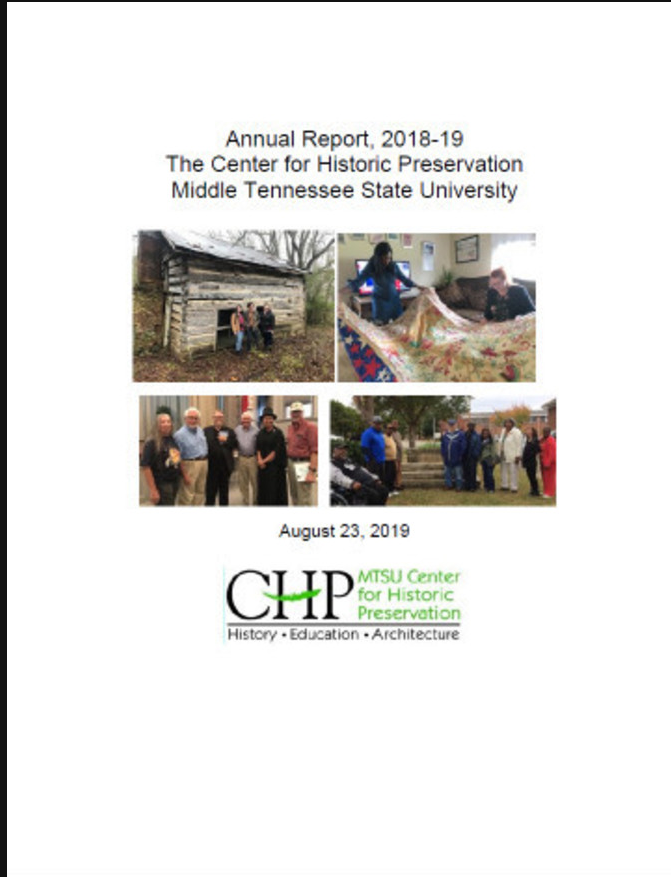

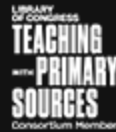
## Annual Report
