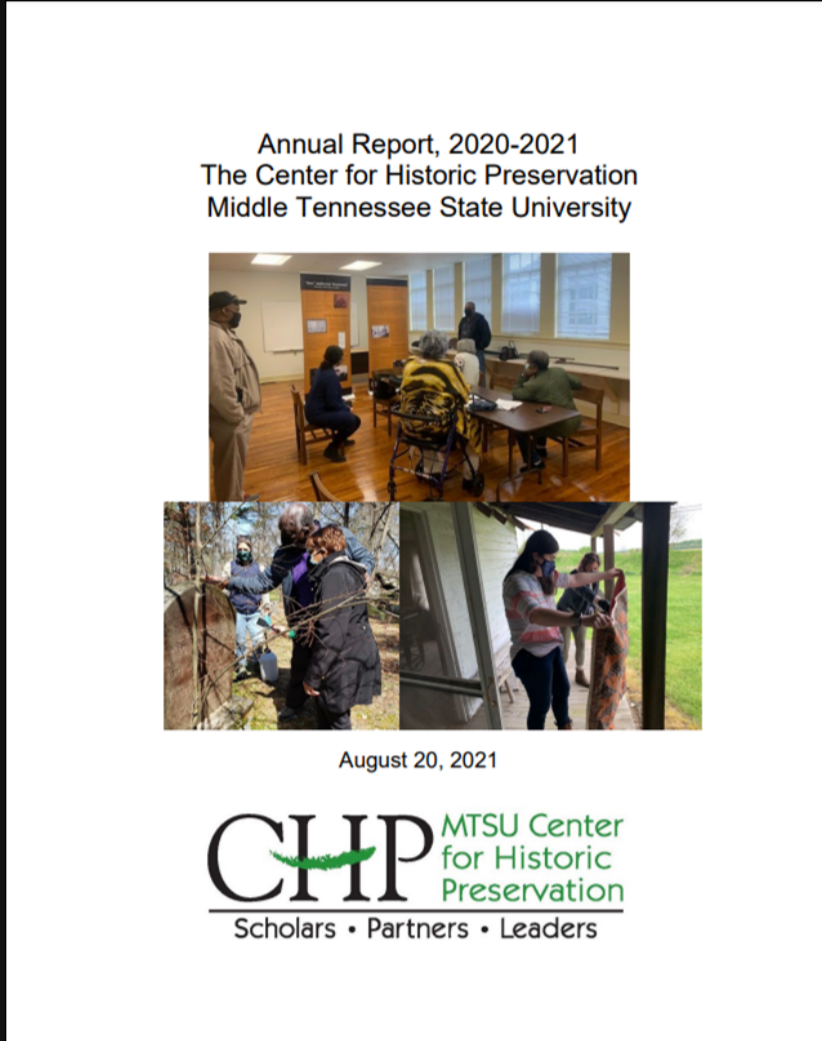

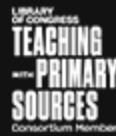


Annual Report
